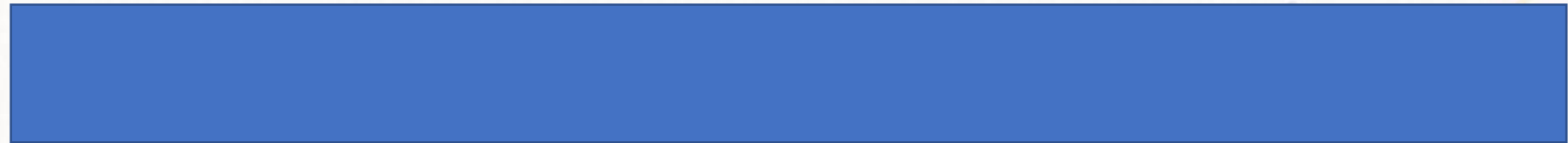

# Emotions

Happy = Malipayon

Angry = Nasuko

Confused = Naglibog

Upset = Nahiubos

So happy = Pirting lipaya/  
Malipayon kaayo

Pirti = Napaka

More conversational

So happy = Lipaya

So Angry = Sukoa

So confusing/ so confused = Liboga

*Liboga oi! = sobrang nakakalito*

*Liboga nimo oi! = You are so confusing*

Disappointed = Nahiubos

I'm so disappointed in you = Nahiubos kaayo ko nimo.

So happy = Pirting lipaya

Feeling sad = Magul-anon root word: guol

*Nganong magul-anon man ka? = Bakit malungkot ka?*

More conversational

Happy = Lipaya

*Lipaya niya gyud! = Sobrang saya niya!*

Angry = Suko

*Sukoa niya gyud! = Galit na galit siya*

Confused = Liboga = Litong lito

Disappointed = Nahiubos = Nadismaya

So happy = Pirting lipaya = Sobrang saya

Annoying = Makalagot

*Makalagot kaayo ka! = You are so annoying*

Makalagot kaayo! = Nakakainis!

Lagot [LAH-gooht] = maddening

Suko [su.kû.] = mad; angry

Makasuko

*Makasuko ang iyang gibuhay = Nakakagalit ang ginawa niya*

I'm angry = Nasuko ko



# Jealous = Selos

Selosa kaayo ka!/ Selosa gyud ka oi! = Napakaselosa mo!

Selosa ka? Are you a jealous type?

Envy = Suya = Inggit

Suyaa = as expression “I’m envious”

Suyaa nako oi! = \*galit ka sa ginawa ng tao tapos hindi ka nakaganti

Nasuya ko nimo = I felt envious of you

Nasuya ka? = Naiinggit ka ba?

Baga *[ba.gâ.]* ka'g(ka+og) naw'ng =  
Ang kapal ng mukha mo!

Hambog = Hambogero

Hamboga oi! = Napakahangin nito

Fear = Hadlok


Natakot ako = Nahadlok ko

Nakakatakot = Makahadlok

Frightening = Makahadlok; Kuyaw  
kuyaw=delikado; dangerous

Natakot ako = Nakuyawan ko  
Unsure = dili sure / di' sigurado  
Interesting= ??

**Naa sa sulod**

**sa basket**

It's inside the basket

Likod or luyo  
= back

*[NAH-ah sah looh-yooh sah TAH-noohm]*

**Naa sa luyo sa tanom**

It's behind the plant

[Ah-sah ahng EEH-reehng]

[NAH-ah sah ah-tooh-BAH-ngahn sah SEEH-yah]

**Naa sa atubangan**

**sa siya**

It's in front of the chair

Command: Atubanga ko = Harapin mo ko

Root word = atubang

Face me = atubang nako

[Ah-sah ahng EEH-reehng]

**Naa sa kilid sa bola**

It's beside the ball

[Ah-sah ahng EEH-reehng]

**Naa sa tunga**  
**sa bola ug sobre**

It's in the middle of the ball  
and envelope

Nasa gitna ako =  
Naa ko sa tunga

[Ah-sah ahng EEH-reehng]

[NAH-ah sah gah-wahs]

**Naa sa gawas**

It's outside

Opposite:  
Sulod = inside

[Ah-sah ahng EEH-reehng]

**Naa sa eskina**

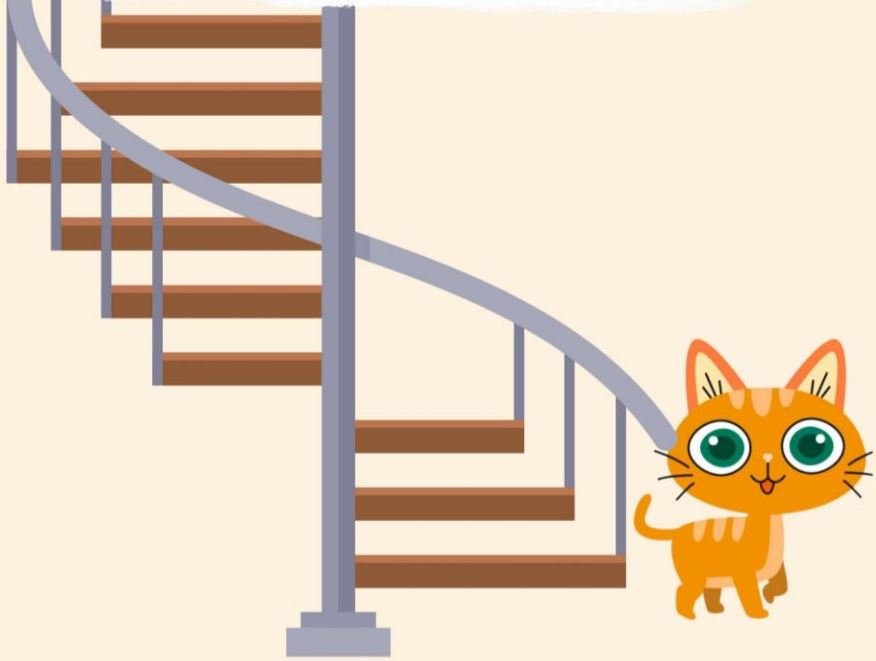
It's at the corner

It's below the stairs

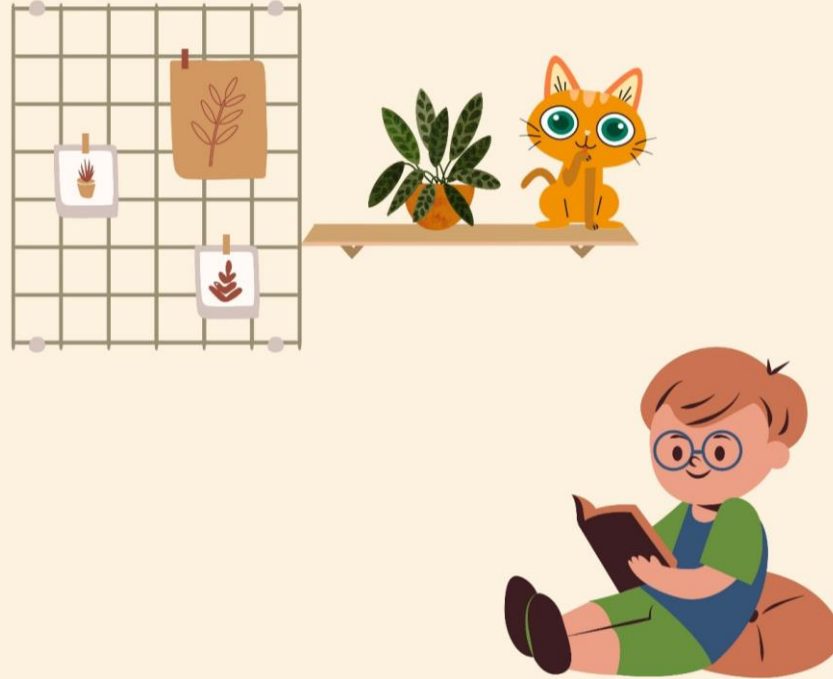
Upstairs = sa taas

Downstairs = sa ubos/ sa silong
