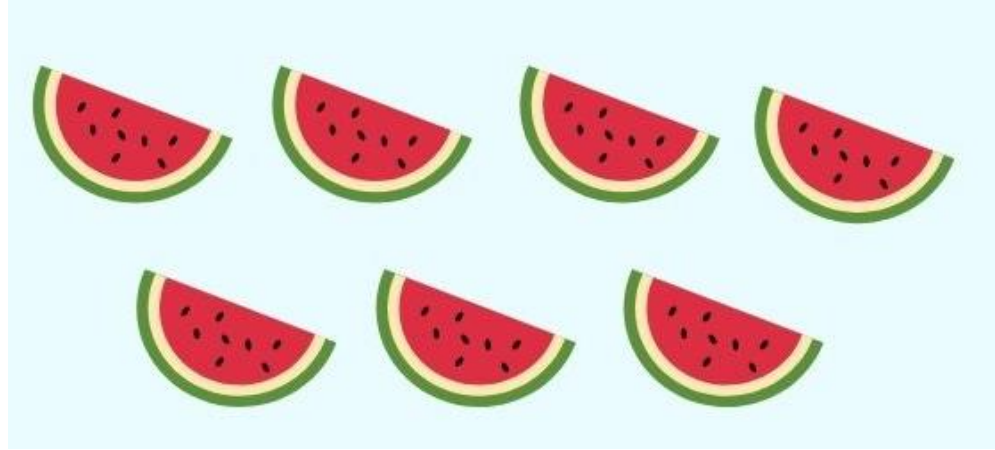

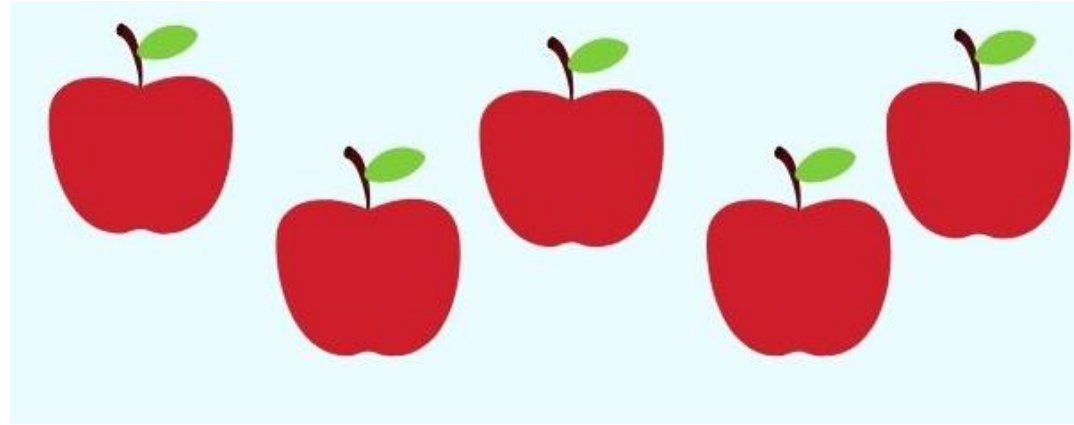

- involves movement

Prefix mag- future tense – Subject focus

Pila kabuok Negosyo nimo?

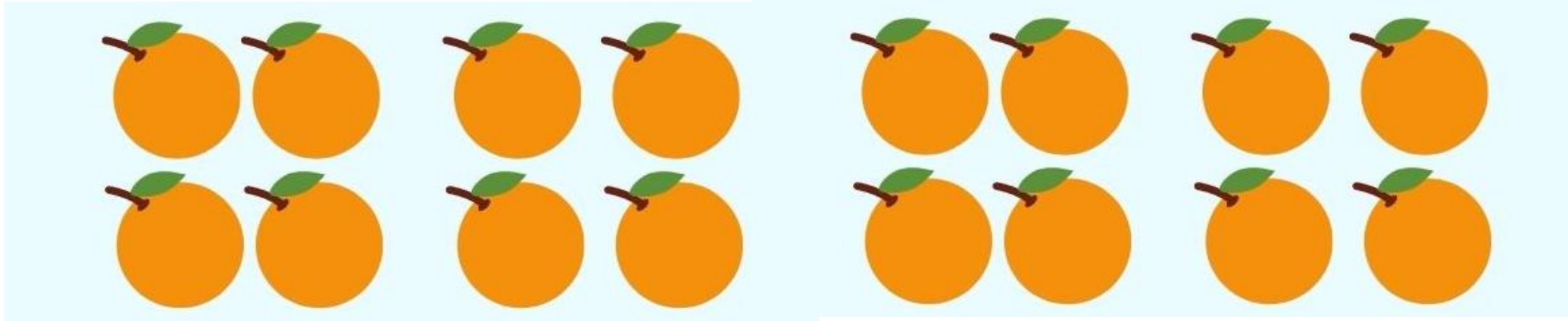

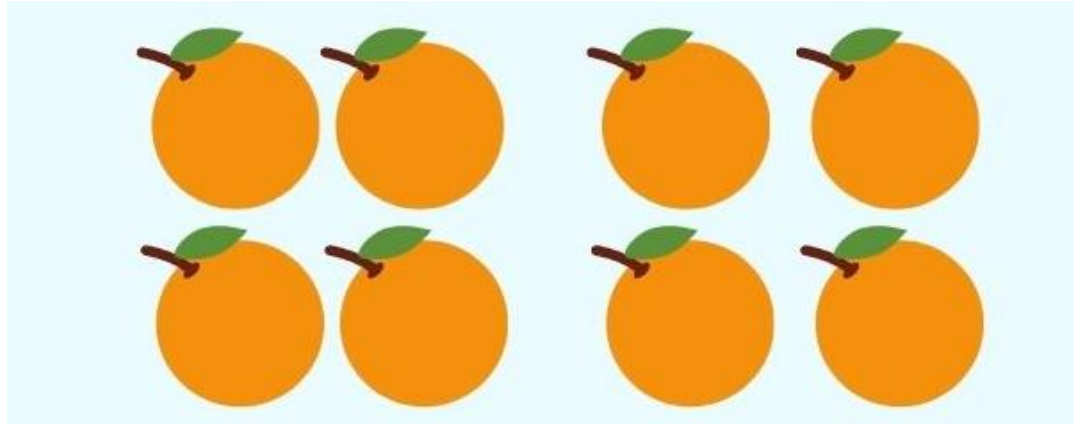

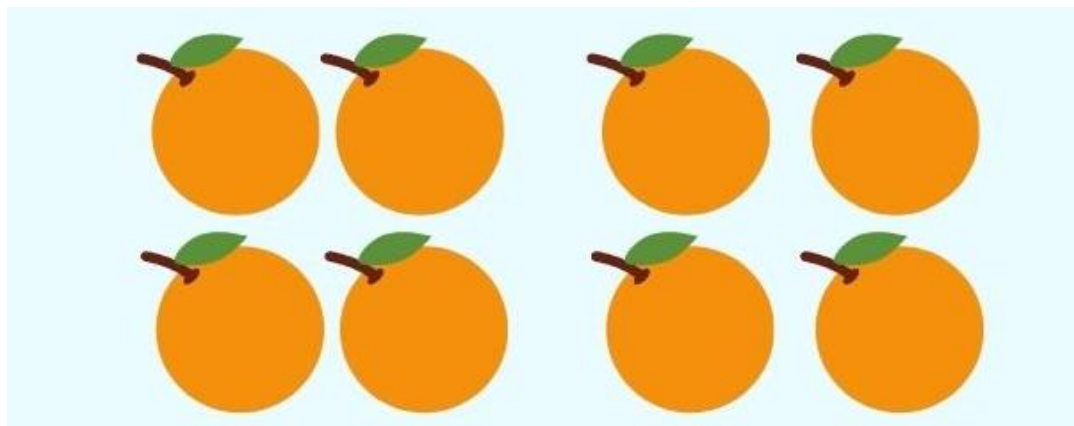

Lima kabuok = 5 pieces
singko ka buok **xxx** = P5.00
onse kabuok = 11 pieces
onse (pesos) = P11.00

Tagpila ning libro? *ni= kini*

Pila nalang ka libro ang nabilin?

How many books are left?

Ilang oras = Pila ka oras

Ilang araw = Pila ka adlaw

Months = Bulan / Buwan

Bulak = flower = buwak

Cotton = gapas

How many projects are you currently working on?

Pila kabuok imong gitrabaho nga project karon?

Prefix Gi- = past tense/ progressive
currently/now = karon / 'ron

Pila kabuok project nimo 'ron?

Ilan ba yung project mo ngayon?

Meron akong tinatrabaho ngayon.

Naa ko'y gitrabaho karon.

Naa'y gitrabaho karon.

Mer

Wala koy gitrabaho.

Wala akong tinatrabaho.

May tinatrabaho ka ba?

Naa kay gitrabaho?

Group 2 chat answers:

May gitrabaho ka? = **parang Ilonggo sounds po ito*

Naa imong gitrabaho? = Andiyan pa ang trabaho mo?

How many emails do you receive each day at work?

Receive = nadawat [past tense]

madawat [infinitive form]

trans: pila ka email ang imong madawat kada adlaw

How many emails did you receive?

Trans: Pila kabuok emails imong nadawat?

How many emails do you receive each day at work?

Received = nadawat [past tense]

madawat [infinitive form]

Pila ka email imong madawat kada adlaw sa trabaho?

How many emails did you receive?

Pila ka emails nadawat nimo?

Prefix na – past tense

Tanggap = Dawat (root word)

Natangap = nadawat

Natangap mo ba yung pasalubong ko?

Nadawat ba nimo ang akong pasalubong?
