Additional Time Markers

Early = Sayo

Late = Dugay

Tomorrow morning = Ugma sa buntag

Later tonight = Unyang gabii

Later in the afternoon = Unyang hapon

Every = Kada / Matag

Every hour = Kada oras / Matag oras

Every day = Kada adlaw / matag adlaw

Ang aga mo ngayon.

Sayo man lagi ka karon.

Manihapon ta! = Let's have dinner!

Manihapon pa ko. = Maghahapunan pa ako.

Nanihapon pa ko = Naghahapunan pa ako.

Additional Time Markers

Sometimes = Usahay / Talagsa / Panagsa

Always = Pirmi / Sige

Since = Sukad ex: sukad pagkabata / since childhood

Rare = Talagsaon

Rarely = Panagsa

A long time ago = Dugay na/Sa unang panahon

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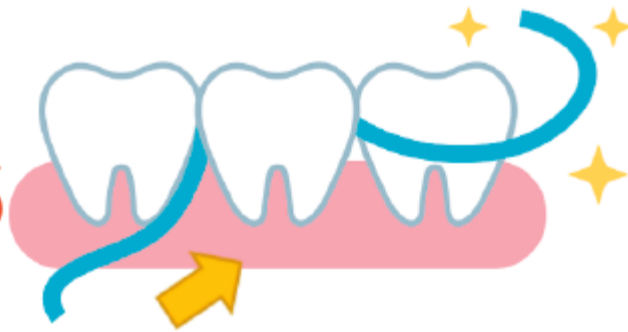

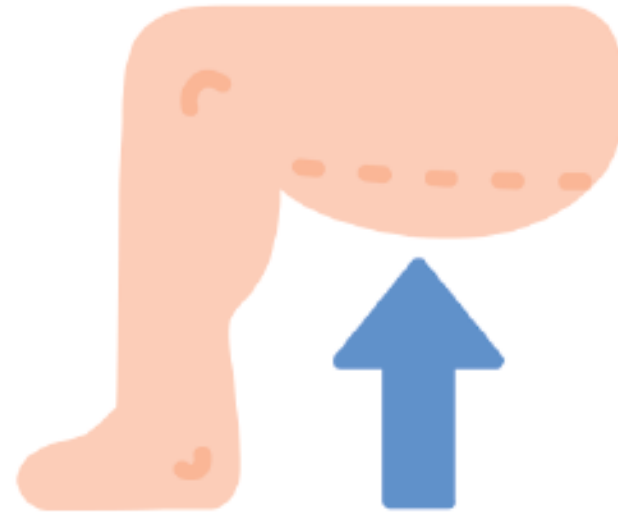

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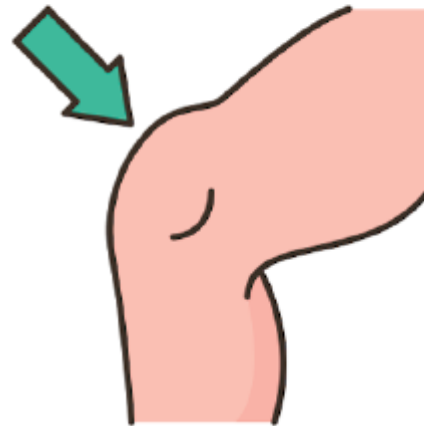
